Executive Summary:

San Martin was the 1st or 2nd rest stop for all riders this year—same as last year.

Mardi Gras theme was popular (again): music and beads. Inflatable arch popular for pictures.
Water delivery from Costco worked great again, saved much time and effort.
Too much water, as it was cool.
PBM was very helpful as well—thanks to Mike Lima

Food:

1. Was **great** to have homemade breads at start—riders loved it.
2. Coffeemaker had problems. 30-cup tripped off after 5-10 minutes, delayed brewing. Recommend have 2 pots next year (for backup), and to stagger brewing. It's important if it is colder weather (like this year or last).
3. **Awesome that Richard** delivered extra food: Nutbreads, noodles, etc. very helpful!
4. Needed to buy soap/bleach as logistics had run out. Sent volunteer.
5. Detailed food report attached.

Improvements This Year

1. "Crew Chief" assignments helped with organization on day of event.
 - a. Food tent chief, Food Service tent chief, Beverage chief, Rider Welfare, photographer, Site check, Rider Counters, food prep (3), food service (3), Bike Racks (3)
2. Made binder with Laminated Rest Stop Info for volunteers
3. Pizza Party 1-week prior: introductions, Crew Chief Assignments
4. Put bike rack near restrooms
5. Safety had a good setup this year: placement of cones, volunteers, canopy made it clear to riders how to enter/exit rest stop. We used SOUTH driveway for both entrance and exit to rest stop.

Improvement for Next Year:

1. Recruit volunteers for next year immediately after this year's ride. (Done)
2. Review assignments individually with Crew Chiefs before event:
 - a. Site setup
 - b. Food Prep
 - c. Food Service
 - d. Site Inspection
 - e. Counter
 - f. Rider welfare
 - g. Site Condition
3. Site Tear-down instructions:
 - a. Timing, order, what to do with spare food, water, personal equipment.
4. Create loading / unloading plan for truck
 - a. First in / Last out arrangement
 - b. First out: Tents, Hot Water Equip., Tables, Igloos, Bike Racks, Coolers
5. Get donations for volunteer coffee and donuts
6. Invite safety and HAM radio operators to pizza party?

2 bike racks

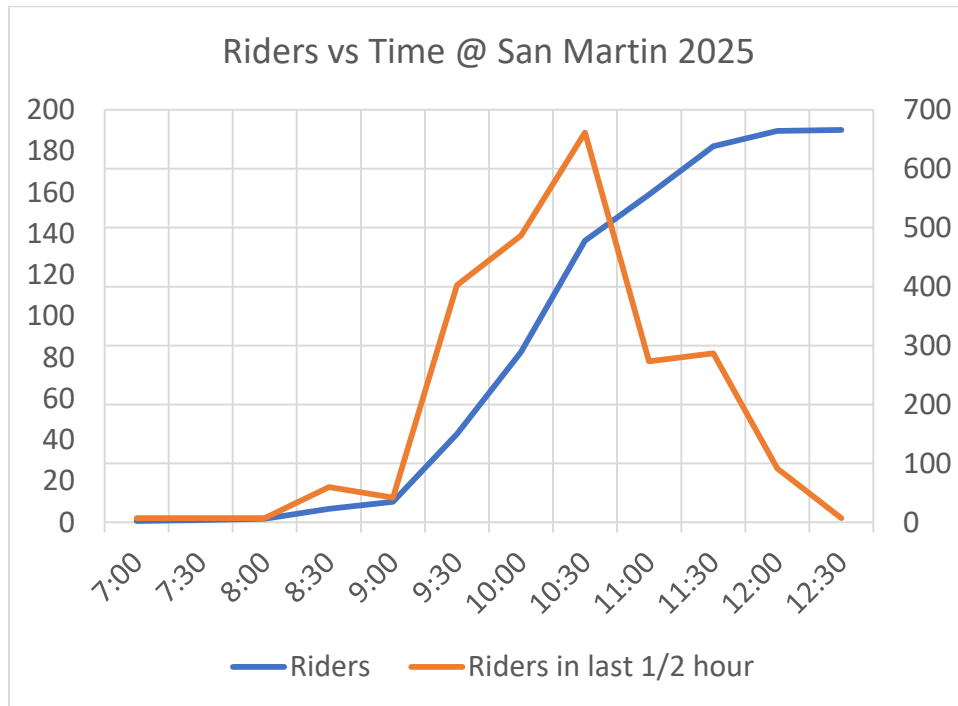
Porta-Potties and Hand-Washing Station
